Tasty Non-Vegetarian Platters is available to Members on Weekends at very attractive rates.



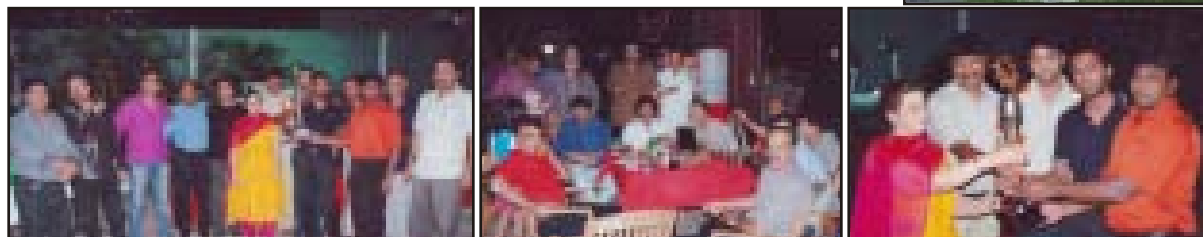
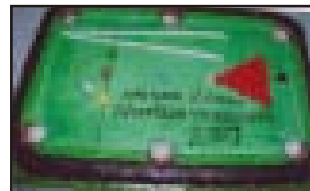
## BILLIARDS

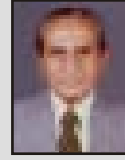
