Although we have been serving you, our esteemed members, for about three and half months, we feel we have yet to qualify to your expectations.

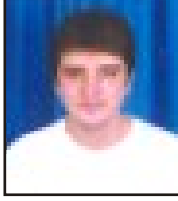
The liquor, soft drinks, drinking water and soda are periodically sent for Lab Tests. The ice making machines & filtration system are serviced regularly.

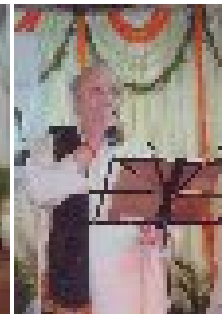
Members are requested to come in 'ethnic wear' so as to enhance the spirit of the occasion.

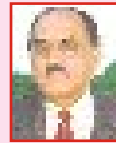
